Every time a cashier swipes your Kroger card at the checkout, points are assigned to your card. Those points turn into dollars for the dogs on a quarterly basis. Dollars that help us provide much needed vet care and supplies to our furry friends! It's that easy!



To Use the Kroger Community Rewards Program:

- Simply register online at www.krogercommunityrewards.com. To Use the Kroger Community Rewards Program:
- Be sure to have your Kroger Plus card handy and register your card with Waggin' Tails Dog Rescue (Don't forget the apostrophe in Waggin') after you sign up.
- If you do not yet have a Kroger Plus card, they are available at the customer service desk at any Kroger.
- Click on Sign In/Register.
- Sign up for a Kroger Rewards Account by entering zip code, clicking on favorite store, entering your email address and creating a password, agreeing to the terms and conditions.
- You will then get a message to check your email inbox and click on the link within the body of the email.
- Click on My Account and use your email address and password to proceed to the next step.
- Click on Edit Kroger Community Rewards information and input your Kroger Plus card number.
- Update or confirm your information.
- Enter name of organization, select organization from list and click on confirm.
- To verify you are enrolled correctly, you will see your organization's name on the right side of your information page.
- REMEMBER, purchases will not count for Waggin' Tails until after your card(s) have been registered.
- Members must swipe their registered Kroger Plus card or use the phone number that is related to their registered Kroger Plus card when shopping for each purchase to count.
